Dr. Ming-Jun Tsai graduated from School of Medicine, Chung Shan Medical University and finished his PhD program on Cheng-Kung University. Dr. Ming-Jun Tsai is now the Chief of Division of Neurology, Tainan Municipal An-Nan Hospital-China Medical University and the Assistant Professor of China Medical University, Taichung, Taiwan.

Prior to join China Medical University, Taichung, Taiwan, Dr. Tsai served from 2007 through 2011 as Senior Reviewer of Pharmaceutical affair of DOH, which integrated into Taiwan Food and Drug Administration (Taiwan FDA) on 2009. Dr. Tsai has been signed to the US authority of medical device, CDRH of US FDA and Canada authority of medical device, Food and Drug branch, Health Canada for medical device regulation training. On behalf of Taiwan Food and Drug Administration, Dr. Tsai has been invited to Drug Information Association and APEC as a speaker for regulation of Drugs and Medical Devices in Taiwan on 2009 and 2010, respectively. On behalf of DOH, Dr. Tsai also participated in WHO international pharmacovigilance program on 2008.

Dr. Tsai has extensive experience in international regulation of Medical Device and Drugs. For promoting new and high class medical device development in Taiwan, Dr. Tsai also had participated in the integration of programs for enhancing environment of new and high class medical device development in Taiwan.
